
Workshop April 2009

Walking there from Uni takes about 20 min's (go Swanston St northbound, right into Cemetery rd east, Lygon St northbound, east into Lee st until Rathdowne St).

Nearest tram: either [1] or [8] at Lygon/Newry (then 2 blocks east and 1 south).

Car parking: rather difficult (mostly residential zone); try Rathdowne St north of Lee St or Curtain St (e.g., north of Curtain park).
